Willsboro, N.Y. — Ada May Green, 91, died at the Parrish Medical Center in Titusville, Fla., on Sunday, June 30, 2002, after a long illness. For many years, Mrs. Green made her summer home in Willsboro and her winter home in Florida.

She was born in Schenectady, N.Y., on Nov. 10, 1910, the daughter of Ernest and Rachel Anna (Sarringer) Cooper.

Mrs. Green was a member of the Willsboro United Methodist Church, the Indian River City Methodist Church in Titusville, the Willsboro Senior Citizens and the United Methodist Women of Willsboro.
