PLATTSBURGH — Mr. Allan F. Mills Sr., 65, of McDonough Street, Plattsburgh, passed away unexpectedly Sunday, May 21, 2006, at the CVPH Medical Center. He was born in Hartford, Conn., on Sept. 28, 1940, the son of Daniel and Mary (Crooms) Mills.

Allan retired from the U.S. Air Force after 26 years of service. He then worked for the U.S. Postal Service in Plattsburgh for 17 years before he became disabled as a result of being hit by a motor vehicle. Allan was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 125 and the American Legion Post 20. He enjoyed playing the lottery, scratch off games and going to the casino.

His parents; four brothers, Roland, Harold, Daniel and Frank; and a sister, Lucille Batchelder predeceased Allan.
