KEESEVILLE — Alzier A. Budich, 84, formerly of Keeseville Country Gardens, passed away Wednesday, May 31, 2006, at Meadowbrook Healthcare in Plattsburgh.

Alzier shared Kathryn's love of Scottish terriers and she will be missed by her newest Scottie "grandson," Baxter MacTavish.

Alzier was predeceased by her parents; her husband; her brother, Charles V. Persina Jr.; and son-in-law, Robert J. Moore.
